*Because it promotes consistency and ease of tuning during group practice, I encourage my students to buy the specific items I've detailed below. You may be able to find the same set-up by searching other vendors on the Internet. That is fine. If you don't see this exact set-up on the site you wish to do business with, phone them. Many times they can put this package together for you. Make sure you get the same chanter length, "LONG" and remember, your choice of reed makes a difference in tuning. If you have any questions feel free to contact me by phone or email. If you are a visitor to my site and plan to join a pipe band in another area, I would suggest you buy a chanter based on the recommendation of their Pipe Major.*
